Admissions Criteria – In Order of Ranking

No	Criteria	Explanation
1	LAC	Children who are, previously LAC, adopted or previously adopted
2	Vulnerable Children	Children of families with confirmed refugee status. Children with physical or medical needs where written evidence from a senior clinical medical officer and GP highlights it would be detrimental to not admit them to the school. Children where one or both parents have a disability that would make travel to a different school very challenging. Children from families associated with Military Services and eligible for Service Premium.
3	Sibling Connection	Having a Brother/Sister attending. This means children who live together in the same house, including biological, adopted, step and foster siblings.
4	Location (within Parish)	Children who live within the designated area of the parish of Sissinghurst.
5	Practising Christian	Children who (with parents/guardians) regularly attend public worship within the Parish of Sissinghurst. This should be detailed on a completed Supplementary Information Form.
6	Location (outside of Parish)	Children living closest to school are given priority.

In the event of a tie (meaning two or more applications are unable to be separated), we will offer places to those who live nearest to the school. This will be measured in a straight line using the National Land and Property Gazetteer (NLPG) address point.
