## Get Tax-Free Childcare: step by step

Check if you're eligible for Tax-Free Childcare, how to apply and how to pay your childcare provider.

## 1. Step1: Check you're eligible,

- 1. <u>Check if you're eligible for Tax-Free Childcare</u>
- 2. Find out what types of childcare you can use

## 2. Step2: Check if you'll be better off,

Your tax credits will stop immediately if you successfully apply for Tax-Free Childcare. You (and your partner, if you have one) will also have to cancel your Universal Credit and childcare vouchers.

#### 3. Step3: Apply for Tax-Free Childcare,

There's one application for Tax-Free Childcare and 30 hours free childcare. As part of your application, you will find out if you can get both.

1. Apply online for Tax-Free Childcare

If you're eligible you'll get a childcare account. You can use this to pay your childcare provider.

#### 4. Step4: Sign in to your account to pay your childcare provider,

1. Sign in to your childcare account

# 5. And Reconfirm your details every 3 months,

You must confirm your details are up to date every 3 months.

1. Sign in to your childcare account to confirm your details
