All children know they can talk to any adult if they are worried or unhappy.

If you need to talk – adults will listen.

Adults are always there for you – just ask or write a note so we can be there for you. Or tell a friend who will help you get an adult to listen.

Someone says things that you do not like

Someone upsets you

Someone touches you without your permission

Someone tries to give you tablets, cigarettes or vapes, drugs or alcohol

Someone hits or hurts you

You get unkind messages on your phone or device.
