In Literacy this term we shall be focussing on developing our story writing skills. We shall be using time connectives, full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and adjectives within our writing. We will also be learning to spell the tricky words accurately, including the days of the week.

In History, we shall be finding out about explorers from the past and present-day explorers and identifying the fantastic achievements that they have accomplished.



In maths this term we shall be introducing early multiplication and division. This will be in the form of 3 groups of 5 is etc.

We shall also be beginning to look at fractions of shapes and numbers.

Class trip

This term it is also our class trip. We shall be going to Sissinghurst grounds on Thursday 12th May. We shall be meeting at Sissinghurst grounds, and the children shall also need to be collected from there. There have been a variety of activities planned such as a camouflage activity, finding out about the different gardens and a nature hunt. This trip links very well to the science topic that we shall be covering – Introducing plants. During this topic we shall be finding out about different types of trees, flowers, and naming the different parts of a plant.
